We are very pleased to advise our School Community that our application for the Kimberley Schools Project Mid-year opt in was successful and we are now included in the Project. For those who were not at school camp, particularly the School Council Meeting, The Kimberley Schools Project focuses on targeted teaching strategies and explicit instruction primarily in the K-2 age bracket in Literacy and Numeracy. The program will also benefit remedial students. Teaching staff will be provided with ongoing Professional Learning, coaching and support on Explicit Instruction.

Staff attended the Let's Decode (Phonological Awareness) PD with Dr Lorraine Hammond yesterday and we will shortly begin planning discussions to implement the program in Term 3.
