#### **New Timetable**

Please find attached the new Air timetable that will commence Week 6 , Monday 9th March.

The increased on air time will mean that the Math concepts each week will be able to be addressed explicitly by the classroom teacher.

The teachers will work from the Stepping Stones book. The starting point that each teacher uses may not be where you are up to, but the whole idea is to get the students back together and to work through concepts with their class teacher.

Increased air times will mean that there will be less time available for set work. It is all about communicating with your teacher as to how much you need to get through and if there are difficulties that you may face. Five hours a day of contact is the rule of thumb that you should be working to, PP-6.

With the introduction of the new timetable there will be a couple of sites where more than one student will be on air at a time. This may be a challenge but the benefits outweigh the problems that may occur. We have worked hard to minimise the clashes. Headsets are advised.
